

ABOUT END STRETE SLEEPING COLLABORATION

End Street Sleeping Collaboration is a cross-sector partnership founded in recognition that no single organisation or strategy, regardless of how large or successful it may be, could solve a complex social challenge, like ending rough sleeping, at scale.

Approach is built around assisting communities across NSW to form local or regional campaigns to end rough sleeping by making it rare, brief and non-recurring. Each local or regional campaign is composed of a collaboration of homelessness, housing, health and community organisations. The success of each campaign is underpinned by the adoption of collaborative practices in the support of people rough sleeping. These collaborations are facilitated by the use of a shared register of information, referred to as the By-Name List.

FUTURESTEPS PROJECTS

FutureSteps has supported:

The role of Project Backbone is to provide and manage the By-Name List and undertake the coordination, convening, communication and reporting functions including the development of strategies and improvement projects for systems change.
